

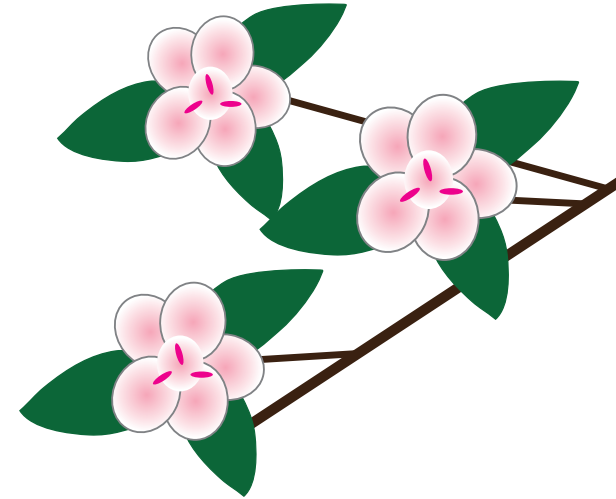
AWARDS

Level Completion – Once a team or individual has earned 100 points in any particular level a Certificate of Completion and a Ribbon will be awarded.

Honor Class – Certificates of Recognition are awarded for any Honor Class performance.

Save the form to your computer, fill in your information and save again. Attach the Entry Form to your email along with your Video Link via YouTube, VIMEO, or Hightail. Your performance video link, entry form and payment must be received by March 30 Midnight, US Pacific Time. If you are sending the video separately from the entry form, please be sure to specify this on the "subject" line of the email. Any entry form, payment, or performance video received after the March 30, 2019 deadline will not be accepted and will be returned to the handler. If mailing, allow 10 days if within the U.S.

You will be sent an acknowledgement that your performance, entry form and payment have been received.

If you are not able to send your performance file through any of these four above listed services, please contact ChallengeSubmissions@DogsCanDance.com or call the Dogs Can Dance office (707) 449-1715 for further instructions.

Please refer to the Video Submissions section of your Challenge Guide (page 18) for detailed instructions of the Introduction and Conclusion. The time limit on all introductions is 15 seconds. State handler's name, dog's name, division and level. Conclusion should include thanking your dog after the performance. All 4 corners of your performance space, along with the center of each side must be marked with visible objects such as cones or flower pots unless you are performing in the Entertainment Division where no ring size is required.
